It's been a while since we've given you an update on our life and ministry. Here a brief recap of what is happening.

OASIS CHURCH

Things at the church are going well. Among the church family members we are seeing an increased willingness to learn, grow and serve. In recent months we have had a number of people step out in ministry for the very first time. Whether it is teaching Sunday School, playing the guitar or leading Bible study, there is a growing desire for people to use their gifts, talents and skills to build up the rest of the church family. This is a huge source of encouragement to us, as we are finally beginning to see the "priesthood of all believers" in action.

In our last newsletter we mentioned a new outreach at the church called Kodomo Shokudo (Kid's Cafeteria). Now that we are in our 10th

Although she had suffered had Alzheimers for many years, the end came quite suddenly and Chris was unable to make it home before she passed. She was 87 years old. In early April, our whole family will go back to the States for a week to see Chris' father and attend the memorial service. PLEASE PRAY for Chris as she needs to make funeral & burrial arrangements from Japan. This is not an easy task under the best of circumstances, but with the

time-zone difference and a full-time job, communicating with the necessary parties in the States has been a challenge. PLEASE ALSO PRAY for Christ' father. Although he too is suffering from early stages of dementia, he is in shock of her passing. May Jesus be a great source of comfort and strength in the days ahead. He will continue living at the retirement care facility where they have been residing the last 4 years.
