Dear Praying Friends,

Japan, like most countries around the world, has been struggling with the COVID-19 pandemic. The possibility of hosting the 2020 Olympics this summer worries many in the country and about 80% of the population now supports canceling the Olympics or delaying the games for another year.



The good news is that in mid-February Japan started vaccinating health care workers with the Pfizer vaccine. Their plan is to vaccinate people over the age of 65 starting in April. We are hopeful that the vaccine will bring the COVID-19 numbers down rapidly. Whether it will be in time for the start of the summer Olympics in July is still undetermined.

OASIS CHURCH

The Osaka area, as well as other large urban areas in Japan, has been in a state of emergency since December. Needless to say, this has had a large impact on the local church life and daily ministry.

Oasis Church has continued to meet in person each Sunday morning (while following strict safety protocols) as well as offer an online presence for those who want to join us from home. Technology has also enabled us to continue meeting for prayer on Wednesday nights via Zoom.

MEMBER CARE TRAINING OPPORTUNITY

Chris is planning to take an on-line Christian Life Coaching course that will result in her becoming a certified life coach. Upon completion of the course, Chris will offer Life Coaching to JEMS missionaries as a part of her member care duties. This course will begin in April and will include 60 hours of lectures and 110 hours of practicum training with clients. With the limitations to doing ministry because of the coronavirus situation, Chris feels that this is a wonderful opportunity to add another tool to her member care tool belt.

PLEASE PRAY for Chris to learn the concepts and skills well as she studies online towards a Life Coaching Certification. May she be able to use these skills to help JEMS missionaries thrive in Japan.

PLEASE ALSO PRAY for an increase in our financial support base with JEMS. Beginning in 2021, we have lost some regular supporters due to

attrition and the economic crisis caused by the pandemic. In total, we are down about \$400 a month in pledged support. We would also need to raise additional support to help pay for the tuition and expenses of Chris' up-coming Christian Life Coaching class which amounts to about \$3,500. During these challenging days, we continue to trust in God's daily provision.

SCHOOL OF LIVING WATER

A couple of times a month, Chris helps out at a small English cram school called the School of Living Waters in Osaka. The students are of various levels and range from 1st grade to 12th grade. It has been a wonderful opportunity to encourage students to grow in their English language ability and learn Bible verse at the same time.



PLEASE PRAY for the children at the School of Living Waters that while they are studying English that the Gospel will take root in their hearts through their exposure to God's Word.
