# **OASIS CHURCH**

Last Spring one of the women in the church felt led to open a *Kodomo Shokudo* (lit. Kid's Cafeteria) at Oasis Church. Kodomo Shokudo is a nationwide program where civic, private and religious

groups provide free meals to children. This might not seem like much of a problem in a wealthy nation like Japan, but with a growing number of single mothers, more and more children are being left to find their own meals while their moms are at work. At Oasis Church, we have started providing this service to children once a month. Since June, church members have been passing out flyers at the local elementary school inviting the kids (and their parents) to come and join us. After a homecooked meal, various church people organize songs, games and English activities for those in attendance. As a church, we hope that this will be a great way to not only serve a need in our community but also to build relationships with families who live near-by. So far, attendance has been low, but once word begins to spread and school starts up again in the Fall, we are expecting an increase in visitors. Our goal would be to feed 15-20 kids/parents each month. The best thing about this new ministry is seeing the church people get so excited about sharing the love of Jesus with the people in the neighborhood. PLEASE PRAY for Kodomo Shokudo. May God lead many people to join us, that they may receive not only physical food for their bodies, but spiritual food for their hearts as well.

Finally, in our last letter we asked you to pray for two new people at Oasis Church; Ken and Keiko. The good news is that Keiko made a decision to follow Jesus (yeah!). We thank God for that and we ask that you **PLEASE CONTINUE TO PRAY** for growth in her new-found faith. The sad news is that in the last few months, both Ken and Keiko have moved to different prefectures. We are unsure how much we will continue to see them, but we trust them into God's care. **OUR PRAYER** for both is that they would find a wonderful church family in their new cities, where they can learn, grow and continue to walk with Jesus.
